Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Standard fitting, solid color polo style shirts of sufficient length• Standard fitting, solid-color school-spirited t-shirts (i.e. black, gold, gray or white only)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Logos and insignias less than 1 inch• No lace-up tops, sleeveless or cold-shoulder clothing.• No outside organization or tribute/recognition sponsored shirts• Extra-curricular team/club shirts require administrative approval.• No low-cut or bareback or shirts that show midriff.• Students shall NOT wear transparent outer garments.
Pants/ Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Standard fitting, solid color trousers, jeans, joggers, capri pants, knee-length shorts (i.e. blue, black, khaki)• Must be worn at the natural waistline	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No oversized baggy pants• No clothing below the hip line• No skin showing• No overall or coverall pants• No athletic/gym shorts allowed• Pre-K - 2nd grade may wear blue or black leggings.
Dresses/Skirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Solid color skirts, dresses, jumpers at knee-length (i.e. blue, black, khaki)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Jean or khaki material only.
Jackets	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Standard fitting zip-up jackets	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No pullover hoodies• No trenchcoats/dusters/oversized jackets
Headgear	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Zip-up jackets with hoods	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No headgear permitted indoors (i.e. hats, caps, beanies or hoods)
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be worn at all times	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No open toe, open back, strapless shoes, no steel toe shoes/boots, no flip flops or slides

Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be clean and neatly groomed • Natural hair colors/highlights acceptable • Boys must be clean-shaven 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No distracting, extreme, and/or bright hair colors are not acceptable (i.e. blue, green, orange, pink, purple, red, etc.) • No distracting or extreme hair styles (i.e. punk-rock cuts, mohawks, reverse mohawks, or spiked hair higher than one inch) • Sideburns shall not extend below the earlobe
Jewelry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only earrings, necklaces, bracelets, watches, and rings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No mouth grills • No gauges, spacers, spikes, or tracers • No eyebrow, nose, lip, or other facial piercings/jewelry allowed
Backpacks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clear or mesh backpacks only • Personal lunch bags and handbags are acceptable 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extracurricular activity bags shall not be carried throughout the school day

General

ALL DRESS/GROOMING IS SUBJECT TO ADMINISTRATOR'S DISCRETION.

- Students shall wear appropriate undergarments. No pull-ups/diapers allowed.
- Students shall NOT wear sunglasses inside school building/during instructional day unless prescribed by a physician.
- Students shall NOT wear apparel displaying alcoholic or illegal substances, such as tobacco, the occult, religious, violence, death, and/or sexually related content, and any other distracting display.
- Students shall NOT wear any apparel suggesting gang affiliations.
- Exposed tattoos MUST be covered.
- Speciality attire may be worn on designated days as approved by administration.
